ADDENDUM #1

Date: 23 June 2014

Subj: Floyd County Georgia RFQ 14-0627 Vegetation Management Services

During the Site Visit on Friday 20 Jun 2014 the following questions we asked.

Question: Will the county require a pollution rider on required insurance should a large spill occur? Answer: The County will not require an insurance rider because the amount of herbicide used should not warrant it however I would require that a standard spill kit be at hand in case a minor spill occurs.

Question: Will herbicide be used vertically and horizontally to control encroachment of vegetation?

Answer: The intent is ground level control. Vertical spray will be used on the fence only.

Question: Will the County require the clearing/Limb chopping of trees leaning into the 8ft clear zone?

Answer: No, The Airport will manage the trees leaning in the 8ft clear zone.

Question: Does the County want the soil sterilized?

Answer: No, Due to possible erosion of the earth beneath the fence.

Question: Does the County know wetlands require a different type of herbicide?

Answer: Yes - All areas including wet lands will be sprayed IAW Federal and State law

Question: Will the County provide a map of the entire area of the fence line covered for the RFQ?

Answer Yes –Fence line area is marked in the attached map.

Question: Will the County address what the county expects in the open areas where mowing is already being

done?

Question: What does the county expect in the 4ft zone outside the fence when it borders a house where the owner appears to be managing the vegetation or has a garden?

Answer: Floyd County property extends approximately 10ft beyond the fence however these areas should be left alone if the owner is managing.

Question: Will the County require proof of Herbicide license for right of ways and wetlands? Answer: Yes – All submissions including contractor or subcontractor will provide proof of State and Federal regulations regarding licensing. Both the Company and the individual will provide a copy of the license with the bid.


