Request for Bids

Specifications/House Demolition

The City of Rome Georgia is seeking bids from qualified contractors for the demolition of condemned housing located within the incorporated City limits of Rome Georgia. These houses are expected to clear the condemnation process at various times throughout the year. The houses are of a wide range of sizes ranging from 800 square feet up to 1200 square feet. Bidders must provide all labor, tools, equipment and materials necessary for the job as described. Bidding conditions are as follows:

1. The bidder must provide with the bid, the location, with a contact name and phone number of references from three (3) jobs completed within the last eighteen months.

Rome Building Inspectors (Drew Ware 919.740.2481)

2. The bidder must provide a per 100 square feet cost for performance of the complete job. At the time of demolition the actual square footage will be determined by existing tax records and the cost per residence demolition will be calculated based on the per 100 square foot cost provided with this bid.
Example: 1500 s.f. x \$150.00 per s.f.= Total Cost

Bidders Response: 225.⁰⁰ per s.f.

3. All asbestos testing and removal will be completed by the City of Rome before demolition begins.

4. The contractor will receive a "Notice to Proceed" before demolition of any residence begins. A digital photo of the location to be demolished will be provided for proper identification of the location.

Bidders Response: ok

5. The successful bidder must provide a certificate of liability insurance in the amount of \$2,000,000.00 with the City of Rome listed as the additionally insured. Workers compensation insurance is required in accordance with the laws of the State of Georgia.

6. The bidder will have 14 work days to complete the demolition from the date of the "Notice to Proceed".

Bidders Response: ok

7. The bidder must provide with the bid, a recycling plan, if materials are not to be placed in a landfill.

Bidders Response: Brick/blocks to Evans Construction

8. Landfill fees will be paid by the City Of Rome. All debris being deposited at the Walker Mountain Landfill must be identified by each physical location's address.

9. The contractor must provide pricing that is firm for a minimum of one year.

Bidders Response: ok

10. Some of the houses to be demolished will be paid from Federal Funding. Those houses will be designated and attached requirements will be in place. However, Davis-Bacon wages are not applicable to this project.

The bids will be received in the Purchasing Department Conference Room at 601 Broad Street. At the designated time the bids will be opened and read aloud. After a review of all the bids to determine the most responsible and responsive bidder, it is the intention of the City of Rome, Georgia to award the contract on an "All or None" basis in one contract.

It is the intention of the City to award this contract for a period of one (1) year and renew up to a total of three (3) years provided that performance is satisfactory and the bid price does not change.

Scope of Work

House Demolition

The contractor must provide all labor, tools and equipment to completely demolish each residence as designated. This will include trucks, tractors, track hoes or any other items needed for successful job completion.

1. The work area must be designated (flagging tape, barricades, etc.) so as to deter encroachment into the work area.

2. All work must be done during daylight hours so as to limit neighborhood disturbance. Sunday work is discouraged.

3. The contractor should remove any poured footings or foundation as part of the demolition process.

Bidders Response: ok

4. After debris has been removed, any rut, ditch or depression that may exist must be filled and smoothed so as not to create a hazard, such as, standing water, trip and fall situation, broken glass, etc.

5. The contractor should take care to insure there will be not damage to existing roadways, curbing, sidewalks or any signage within the right-of way.

6. Before payment will be made the work site must be inspected by a representative of the Building Inspection Department.

7. No quantity is guaranteed.

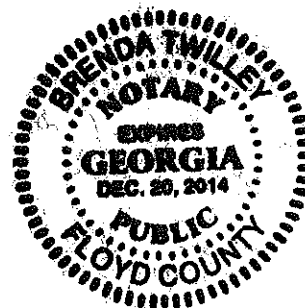

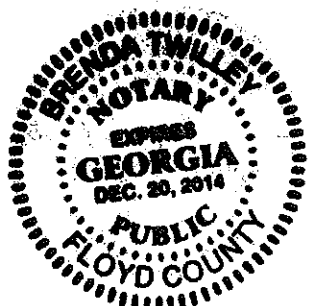
