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Questions and Answers I

JANITORIAL PRODUCTS & PAPER PRODUCTS CONTRACT Bid #20-1105

Q. Can you provide us with the bid tabulation from the previous bid, indicating the award pricing per item and the winning vendor.

A. A copy of the 2015 Bid Tabulations has been posted to the website.

Q. If there were any price increases for the can liners listed in the bid from the original award, can you also provide us with this information.

A. No increases have been noted in the file.

Based on previous ordering history, can you provide us with the following information regarding the can liners:

Q. How many delivery locations are there?

A. There are approximately 13 – 15 different locations.

Q. Based on previous ordering history, can you tell us about how often are placed for the liners (monthly, quarterly or other?) and what is an approximate case order?

A. Each department acts independently and they order independently. Some departments may use more than others and may need an order on a monthly basis while another may only order quarterly.

Q. Can you provide us with the thickness currently being purchased for the can liners that do not list a thickness?

A. The average mil range will suffice. Usually between .4 and .9.

Q. Can you provide us with the case count (liners per case) for the clear drum liners and clear recycling bags currently being purchased.

A. Most cases are shipped with 10 rolls of 10 bags per case.

Q. Regarding the other items listed in the bid, can you also tell us about how many delivery locations there are and approximately how often orders are placed?

A. Again, there are 13 – 15 different locations and each department works independently and place different orders at different times for different items.

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Q. How many locations will be utilizing this contract, and does each location have a loading dock & forklift?

A. As stated above, there are approximately 13 -15 locations and only 1 location would have a loading dock. No fork lifts are available.

Q. How often are orders placed and in what quantities?

A. Each department acts independently and orders quantities they require and at different times as they require. No set amount of quantity or time frame can be determined.

Q. Will this be awarded by line item, or to one vendor?

A. Floyd County prefers to award to one vendor, however, we are not opposed to line item awards if it is in the best interest of the County.
